# North Carolina Community College Mathematics Competition

**Hosted by Durham Technical Community College**



**Saturday, November 19, 2011**

***Eligibility Requirements:*** Any student attending a two-year college who does not have already have a degree and has never taken a math course beyond the sophomore level is eligible to compete for their current institution.

***Content:*** The competition will consist of two parts: a morning calculus exam (90 minutes, 40 questions, multiple-choice) and an afternoon team competition containing solely pre-calculus problems. Approximately two-thirds of the calculus exam questions will pertain to Calculus I topics; the rest will pertain to Calculus II topics.

***Tentative Schedule of Events:***

Registration:	9:45-10:30
Calculus Test:	10:30-12:00
Lunch:	12:00-1:30
Team Competition:	1:30-3:30 (approximately)
Awards Ceremony:	30 minutes after team competition ends

***Prizes:*** Awarded to the individuals with the top three scores on the morning exam, the teams with the top three scores in the afternoon competition, and the colleges with the top three combined overall scores (from morning and afternoon competitions).
